

This Sunday Jennifer Johnson is proposing a 24 hour fast for the women in the movement. Her email is outlined below:

Dear Sisters,

As soon as I became aware of this unfolding situation, I spent many hours trying to understand both sides and get an understanding as to what was and is going on. I considered many times adding my opinions but when I witnessed some of the stress at the end of the zoom meetings, where cracks opened up in the participants demeanors for a second and I got to see into their hearts and feel their pain and frustration, their humanness and benevolence, I couldn't find my voice. I'd felt their hearts, and for a second my heart began to hurt with theirs but I could only imagine the myriad of feelings, the depth of heartache, pain, even fear for a whole year as each side believed they are working for the Lord to humbly do His will. I have come to the conclusion that without having been present for any of it there is really nothing I can offer in the way of advice on how to resolve the problem.

There is something I think we can do however, even though we feel helpless in this situation and our hearts are breaking for our dear sisters on both sides and the one stuck in the middle.

I'd like to propose a 24 hour fast this Sunday by as many of us as possible. Humbling ourselves before the Lord as a group and offering up broken hearts and contrite spirits for blessings of clarity, understanding, peace and love on behalf of all these sisters that we love so dearly. If you are interested please forward this to all you believe might join us.

Should you choose to fast and pray with me, I'd like to offer a prayer to join our hearts as one and assist us with the intent and focus of this fast.

Father In Heaven,

As women of the covenant, having heard Your voice and accepted the Covenant of Christ. We fast today in humility and knit our hearts together as a full women's fellowship seeking Fellowship and Wisdom with You. Our desire is to know You better by seeking Your help and thereby drawing closer to all of You to become instruments in Your Hands for good. We accept with gratitude and ask in humility that your servant David's prayer be fulfilled and answered upon our heads. That Your Spirit be poured out upon us to increase the light by which we view the events in this dispensation, the challenges we are facing in life and the choices we have to make. That the Light of Your countenance illuminates the decisions that we now find ourselves pondering. Please turn up the volume so we can hear You that we might receive your instructions with clarity so our understanding will increase. We desperately recognize the need for Your blessing and guidance to accompany us always and especially right now as we face peril in this moment of our journey to becoming a Zion Sisterhood. We know that understanding, heeding, listening to and recognizing, Your voice is essential to us now and always. Please recognize our efforts to show charity and mercy to each other bringing us ever closer together and becoming worthy to be recognized as Your Daughters.

Father we choose You to be our God and we will give heed to Your voice as we serve only You.
